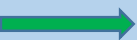

# New school gate

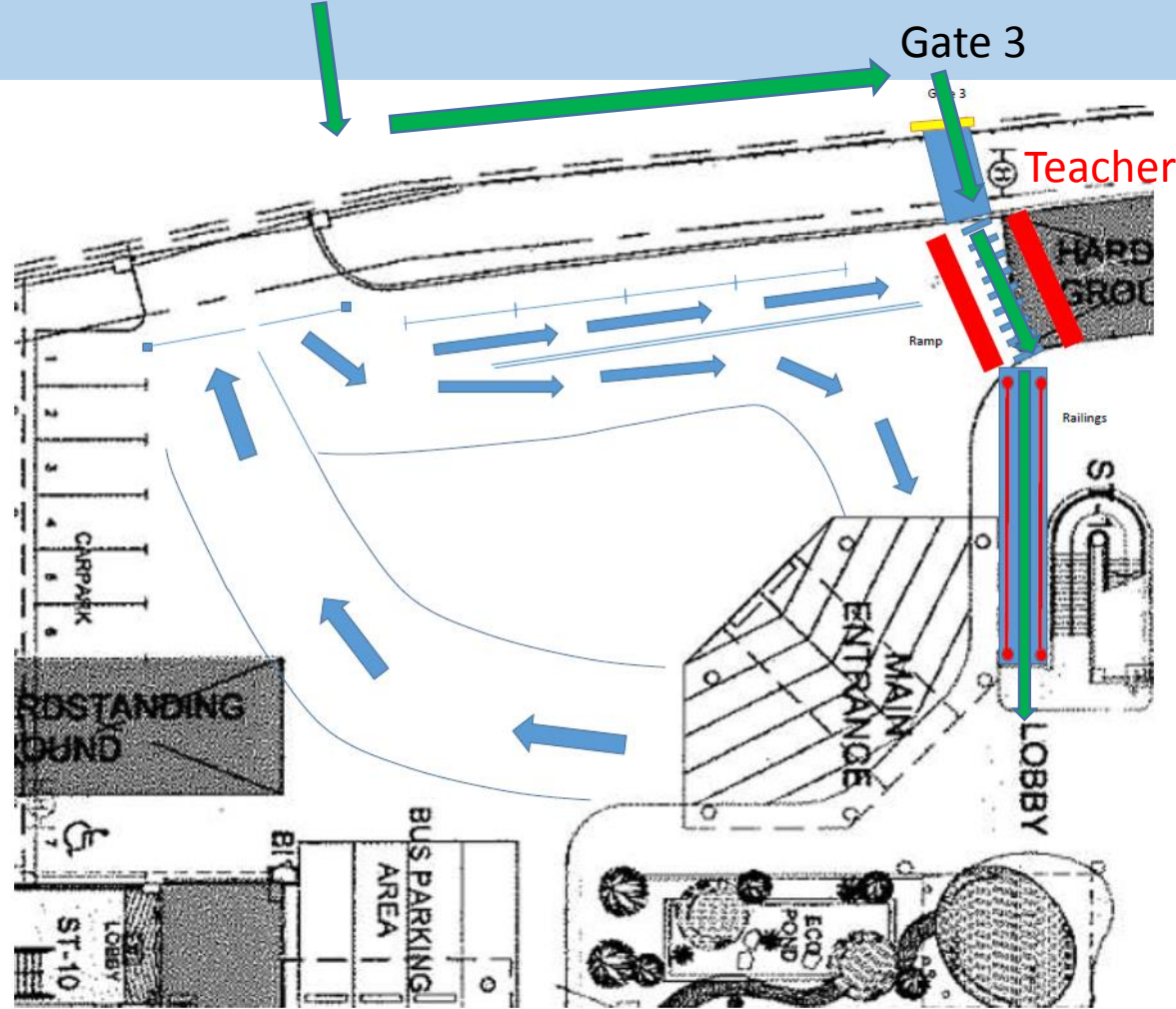

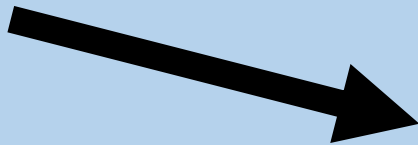
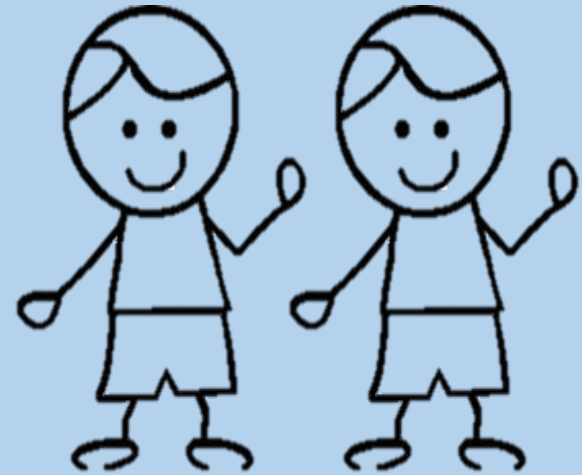
1. All assessments will be conducted during curriculum time and timetable will not be suspended.
